Update on Youth Ministries: Leslie Mendoza on behalf of Jenni Vasquez – provided an update on the youth ministry focusing on Faith Formation and the number of children that will be attending this year. There is concern, however, about the lack of teachers available to assist with Faith Formation

Safe Space Update: Alejandra Aguilar gave a great presentation on the process for being a volunteer. She provided information on how to complete the applications, the different levels of application, and who needs to complete the applications. Alejandra described the reminder system that is in place to keep current volunteers properly certified to continue their work. She also indicated that our ushers need to complete this process, and was going to reach out to them to get that started. There are virtual classes available, but they are not on demand. The certification lasts for 5 years, and Alejandra keeps good records of who needs to renew prior to expiration.

Finance Council and Building Committee update: Dean Penny provided an update on parish growth and the status of current projects, such as the storage building.
