Minutes: Motion to approve the November 2023 meeting minutes was made by Nick Petro and seconded

by Chris Vozdik.

Sound System Update:

Nick Petro

Nick shared a presentation on the sound system in the church. There are three cameras in the church to assist with the livestream. Nick shared how a sound system works and made an analogy to a cake. The sound system includes input, a mixer, one mixed audio signal, and an amplifier which sends the sound to the speaker(s).

The prior speakers (arrays) were powerful, but the replacement costs are high (\$50k+). These speakers are still mounted from the ceiling and will be taken down during the church expansion.

For cost saving purposes: Several speakers and a separate amplifier were installed. The sound is not as good as the prior speakers, but it is good enough. There may be further updates to the sound system once the church expansion is underway.

Challenges with audio: Nick shared that some of the reasons for the audio challenges experienced during mass include: 1) people attempting to adjust the audio to their preference (adjusting the speakers), 2) the mixer (complexity to calibrate – if one button is touched it will skew the entire calibration), and 3) feedback challenges (sound waves).

What can help? Microphone placement and education will help assist with the audio challenges. Nick is happy to assist with this.

Future: The setup (microphones and instruments set up in advance) and minimal movement of the equipment will assist with maintaining a balanced sound throughout the church.

Additional: If a parishioner would like, they may use a personal, portable FM radio. Ushers can provide on if asked prior to the start of mass.

The campaign is off to a strong start.

- ▶ Held 2 in-home receptions prior to Christmas.
 - 16 families attended: 100% committed to contributing to the campaign.
 - \$339,000 in total commitments to date
 - \$139,500 donations received to date.
- ► The first reception for 2024 was held in January: 9 of the 14 families that RSVP'd attended. Ask range for this group totaled \$115,000 \$195,000 total for the group.
- ▶ Prayer Cards are in the Pews with a special prayer for this campaign. The goal is to begin praying together as a community.
