Youth Ministry: Jenni Vasquez

Youth Adult Retreat

Twelve young adults attended the retreat supported by materials from the Christian-Catholic outreach faith study. There are six books in the series. Plans are being made for the group to host a retreat to cover the second book in this study. Jenni is looking to extend the retreat into a deanery style program allowing other young adults within the diocese to attend.

High School Youth Ministry

The high school youth ministry group has several events planned each month during the summer including a prom committee, Steubenville, Ohio trip, and a water park trip. They will also participate in this year's Novena and are actively mentoring youth in the middle school ministry.

Middle School Youth Ministry

Participation is low for the middles school youth ministry, but Jenni and the high school group are actively exploring ways to increase attendance. The Ladies Guild recently assisted the group with making a craft at one of the weekly sessions.

Confirmation Class of 2023

92 young adults became confirmed in April. Several of the confirmed have expressed an interest in returning in the fall of 2023 as catechist assistants.

Jenni is working with Father Peter and the Finance Committee to hire an assistant to help Jenni with the various duties that support our youth.
